
## **UNM IC-CAE Summer Research Funding Opportunities** for **UNM Undergraduate and Graduate Students**

Twenty students from UNM campuses will be chosen for stipends of \$3,000 to conduct research, write an 8-page research paper, and present a poster on a topic involving global, national, or human security<sup>1</sup> (GNHS is a national IC-CAE program). Students should identify a designated



faculty member as a mentor. Projects must be completed during the summer (June - July). Stipends will be awarded in the summer term when the project paper and a poster are submitted and approved. Posters will be presented in September 2022 as part of the UNM Global, National, and Human Security Symposium. Outstanding papers may be chosen for an oral presentation by their authors at the Symposium.

## Eligibility

Applicants must have participated (or intend to in 2022-3) in NSSP/CTSP/CSHS academic programs, meetings, recommended courses and/or sponsored events. Students with a major or minor in STEM areas, such as computer science, information technology, engineering, applied math, statistics, physical or natural sciences, or in global, national or human security studies, such as topics in geography, psychology, economics, political science, international studies, ethnic studies, languages, or sociology are eligible. You must have a successful academic record with coursework related to your research topic and must supply the name of a faculty member who we may contact and has knowledge of your previous work or may work with you on your project. Women, minority and non-traditional students are strongly encouraged to apply.

<u>Step 1</u>. Apply through filling out the second page of this announcement and submit it before May 6, 2022 to gilfeath@unm.edu.

<u>Step 2.</u> You will be notified of acceptance before May 10 or perhaps a preliminary acceptance pending revision of your topic question.

<u>Step 3.</u> Submit a draft paper by July 22 to <u>gilfeath@unm.edu</u>. Comments will be returned within 5 days. Detailed guidelines on preparing research paper and poster will be provided. Step 4. Prepare final paper and poster and submit by August 5, 2022.
